Your crew serves as a valuable resource for local insights, assists with organizing daytime activities, and is responsible for preparing family-style meals onboard.

Captain and Crew Responsibilities:

- Safety of all souls onboard
- Safety of vessel
- Sailing/motoring the vessel
- Driving the dinghy (tender)
- Guided excursions during regular hours
- Creating a personalized itinerary
- Prepared family style meals (not served or plated)

Additional Included Services:

- Provision Service
- Cleaning of common areas on the boat

To enhance your onboard experience, your crew will happily prepare up to three family-style meals per full charter day, based on the preferences you outline in your Provision Preference Sheet. We encourage you to be as detailed as possible when completing this form to ensure your culinary expectations are fully met. To further ensure your satisfaction with the provisioning plan, we will arrange a phone call with your crew within 7 days of your charter date to discuss your preferences. Please note that the crew's responsibilities do not extend to the preparation or service of drinks and snacks. Should you choose to dine ashore, your captain and crew are not expected to join you. However, if you wish to extend an invitation for an onshore meal and they accept, we kindly request that you cover the cost of their meals.

Your Crew's dedicated working hours are from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM with additional daily breaks, as their duties often span beyond their working hours.

Should you feel your captain and crew provided exceptional service, a gratuity is customary and greatly appreciated. The industry standard for professional services ranges from 10-20% of the charter cost.
